


# Making a pull request


## 0. Setting up a fork

Create a copy of the repository you want to submit changes to.  
Go to <https://github.com/sannybuilder/data>


Find “Fork” button and click it:



It will ask about account where you want to fork this repo:



Soon afterwards you should see a new repo under your account:



## 1. Making changes

Navigate to files you want to edit, e.g.

<https://github.com/x87/data/blob/master/sa/SASCM.INI>

Find “Edit” button and click it:



Make changes or copy-n-paste already modified file in the web editor:

## 2. Commit changes



You can modify multiple files and commit their changes too.  
Don't think about a number of commits at this point, they will be reduced down to 1 during the merge process.

## 3. Submitting a pull request


When you are ready and all changes are made, submit a pull request:
